Assisted Living Waiver Program (ALW)

Huntington Hospital Senior Care Network's Assisted Living Waiver Program provides options for frail older adults and individuals with disabilities to reside in an assisted living facility as an alternative to a skilled nursing facility. The program is in partnership with the California State Department of Health Care Services and funded with Medi-Cal funds. Residents pay monthly for room and board from their income to reside in an assisted living facility that participates in the program.

Assisted living facilities are residential long-term care settings where personal care, oversight and other supportive services are provided or coordinated for residents. Services are designed to meet residents' needs as determined through a nursing assessment and care planning process. Residents are assigned a care coordinator who visits monthly to monitor their care.

Eligibility Requirements

You may apply to become a participant in the ALW Program if you meet these requirements.

- 21 years of age or older
- Eligible for Medi-Cal with no share of cost
- Qualify for placement in a skilled nursing facility

Eligibility Determination

Eligibility determination is made through a nursing assessment by Huntington Hospital Senior Care Network. Final determination for enrollment into the ALW Program is made by the California State Department of Health Care Services.
