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SP - MANAGEMENT OF ACUTE ILLNESS

Privileges under the Standardized Procedure for management of Acute Illness _____

Standardized Procedure Includes: Obtaining and documenting patient History and Psychosocial history; Performing and documenting physical examinations; Assessing the acuity level of the illness based on history, physical examination and diagnostic evaluations; Orders treatment (diet, exercise, etc.) - as outlined in the Standardized Procedure; Provides patient education in reference to medication, treatments, outcomes, prevention; Consults/collaborates/refers to the supervising physician as outlined in the Standardized Procedure.

SP - MANAGEMENT OF CHRONIC ILLNESS

Privileges under the Standardized Procedure for management of Chronic Illness _____

Standardized Procedure Includes: Obtaining and documenting patient History and Psychosocial history; Performing and documenting physical examinations; Assessing the acuity level of the illness based on history, physical examination and diagnostic evaluations; Orders treatment (diet, exercise, etc.) as outlined in the Standardized Procedure; Provides patient education in reference to medication, treatments, outcomes, prevention; Consults/collaborates/refers to the supervising physician as outlined in the Standardized Procedure.

SP - ORDERING LABORATORIES AND PROCEDURES

Privileges under the Standardized Procedure for Ordering Laboratories and Procedures _____

Standardized Procedure includes: Ordering therapies, as outlined in the Standardized Procedure; Determining existing condition(s) that may effectively be managed through therapeutic interventions; Monitors effectiveness of ordered therapies; Documents ordered therapies in the medical record; Evaluates the effectiveness of ordered therapies; Provides patient/family education regarding therapies.



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SP - DRUGS AND DEVICES

Privileges under the Standardized Procedure for Drugs and devices

Standardized Procedure includes: Ordering Drugs and Devices based on relevant history and physical examination; and laboratory tests or procedures, as outlined in the Standardized Procedure; Monitoring effectiveness of any medication or device ordered; Provides patient/family education regarding pharmacologic interventions; Communicates to patient/family regarding pertinent side effects or complications with drug or devices ordered; Consults/refers to the supervising physician if patient is non-responsive to appropriate therapy and/or if unusual or unexpected side effects occur, as outlined in the Standardized Procedure.

SP - EXERCISE/PHARMACOLOGIC/PULMONARY STRESS TESTING

Privileges under the Standardized Procedure for Exercise/Pharmacologic/Pulmonary Stress Testing

Standardized Procedure includes: Identifying indications for test, collecting subjective and objective data to detect contraindications to exercise and pharmacologic or pulmonary stress testing; Performs pre-procedural items in accordance with Standardized Procedure; Provides continuous monitoring of patient during test in accordance with the Standardized Procedure; Performs post-procedure patient monitoring; Consults with MD if significant findings, adverse reactions or life threatening situations, etc. are identified, as outlined in the Standardized Procedure; Documents findings/interactions with patient in the medical record.

SP - WOUND CLOSURE

Privileges under the Standardized Procedure for Wound Closure

Standardized Procedure includes: Preparation of wound area with local anesthetic 1-2% lidocaine; Inspection of wound area for foreign bodies/tissue damage; Prep / cleanse the wound area with betadine and/or saline irrigation; as outlined in the Standardized Procedure; Debrid edges of wound, as necessary; Suture wound based on depth of suturing; Provide post-procedure instructions to patient/family.



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SP - INCISION AND DRAINAGE OF AN ABSCESS

Privileges under the Standardized Procedure for Incision and Drainage of an Abscess _____

Standardized Procedure includes: Cleansing area; drapping; anesthetize with 1-2% lidocaine and perform incision & drainage; Obtain culture, as outlined in the Standardized Procedure; Prescribe antibiotics and pain medication; Provide patient education in reference to dressing changes and signs and symptoms of infection.

SP - ADDITIONAL PROCEDURES/PRIVILEGES
