PowerChart Orders





Open chart to Orders tab.

Click the Add Order button




Type order name in **Search** field.

Choose either "Starts with" or "Contains" search option.

Select the desired order in the orders search list.

The Details pane displays at bottom of the window

Required details are bolded and highlighted in yellow.





Complete order details.


The Ordering Physician dialog box displays on the first order.

Enter the first few letters of the physician's last name

Click the **Find** button to view a list of physicians with the same or similar last name.

Select the desired physician's name, and click **OK**.

Adjust the Order Date/Time, if necessary.
Select the correct Communication Type to identify how the order was given, for example, a written order.






indicates missing or required details that must be addressed prior to signing the order.





Note: Order details can also be completed in the Orders for Signature view after all orders have been selected.





To Enter Additional Orders

Repeat steps to adding an order.

Orders For Signature

Click Orders for Signature at the bottom of the screen.

Confirm correct order details.

Note: Duplicate or unwanted orders may be removed prior to signing; right click on the order and select "Remove".

Click **Sign** to place orders.



Copying Existing Orders

1. The **copy** functionality allows users to repeat <u>any</u> order in any order status.

Right-click on order.



- 2. Select Copy.
- 3. Enter new detail(s) if necessary.

 If placing additional orders, click **Add Order** button.
- 4. Sign orders.




Cancel or Discontinue an Order

Select Cancel/DC

Enter cancel reason.

Duplicate Lab Orders

Before entering new lab orders it is essential that users determine that there is not an existing order for the same test.

If another order exists: cancel the existing order first, sign it, and then enter the new order.

If you are placing your own order, you will **not receive notification of a new order.** You will still have to perform a Nurse Review for that order

Any activated order in the order page will have a check mark in front of the order.

You can enter multiple orders and click "Done" when finished.

Once all required fields have been entered, click "Orders For Signature" then sign.

The RN can now review all orders at the same time





Power Plan

A power plan is an order set. It may be for a specific diagnosis or procedure.

The physician is responsible for ALL orders

The Power Plan will be placed in a Planned Pending state by the Admitting Physician

When the patient reaches the inpatient unit (from ED, PACU, etc.), the Power Plan will be in a "Planned State."

After the patient is physically on the unit, the orders will need to be Initiated.


